this year's NBA Draft, UCLA guard Lonzo Ball, is
constantly being compared to Steph Curry. He is a
6'5" point guard who will use his athleticism and shot-
making ability to take over games, just like Curry did
during the NBA Finals a few months back. Ball has a
strong build with a low center of gravity. He's strong
on the ball and has good footwork. He can really put

the ball on the floor and take it to the hole, but his inconsistent form and erratic shot release can often leave his pull-up 3-point shot way off. Ball is averaging about 14 points per game this season with 2.9 assists, 1.9 rebounds and 1.3 steals. Draft Express did a nice write-up of Ball's game, so I'll give you a rundown of his strengths, weaknesses, projected range and fit in the NBA. Strengths Ball's ability to make shots is what separates him from most of the other point guards in this draft. Ball has tremendous touch and he's capable of hitting any shot at any time.

He's not a natural shooter, but he has developed a smooth stroke with a consistent release point. Ball can pull up from about 16-feet in the corner and from anywhere near the paint. He hits the mid-range jumper and he's made a career of hitting off the dribble. Ball has an excellent first step and he's excellent at creating separation. He's capable of either

getting to the rim, finishing at the rim or drawing defenders to him and kicking to the open man. He has a ton of court vision and a great first step, which allows him to get to the rim off the dribble. His shot is smooth and he can pull up from anywhere on the court. Ball has been getting by far the most usage among point guards in college basketball this season.

In this case, the Supreme Court overturned an almost 50 year old conviction. In 1964, three African-Americans – Lester Mathews, Michael Glover, and Samuel Shepherd – were convicted of murder in the bombing of a Philadelphia police station. Glover and Shepherd were sentenced to death. The U.S. Supreme Court was asked to hear

an appeal of the case, and in July 2014, unanimously overturned the conviction. This case marks the first time that the Supreme Court has overturned a federal conviction on the basis of racially-motivated police misconduct. The case began in 1959, when the three men were arrested for the bombing of the police station. All three men were members of the Nation of Islam and viewed the police as racists. At the time, the Nation of Islam was a rising force in Philadelphia, and the men were members of a group called the Black Muslims. The three men were charged with conspiracy, kidnapping, and murder. They were arrested while distributing pamphlets at a bus stop in Philadelphia. The jury heard a lot of physical evidence and testimony that the three men were caught in a gunfight with police in which both Glover and Shepherd were wounded. The key testimony against them was that of a man called Robert

Callahan, who was convicted in a separate trial of conspiracy to commit murder. Callahan was a key witness for the prosecution. He testified that the men had a plan to kill white officers, specifically Lt. Tarrant, but had decided not to kill any police officers. In fact, Callahan testified that the only plan was to kill the policemen. He was a confessed liar, as he had also participated in the bombing. He did so because he believed that the men had harmed him in a way that he
